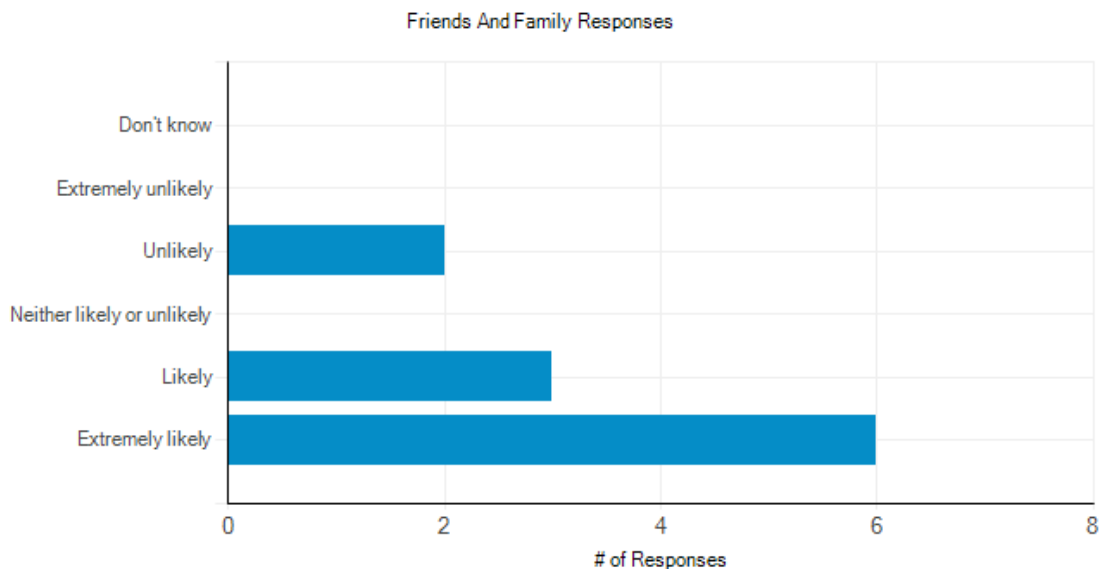


Friends and Family Test Results – September 2017

**Comments received:**

Response #1:

I would have responded "extremely likely" if it were possible to see my own doctor when it was required.

Response #2:

It can be very hard to get an appointment with a doctor or nurse in under 10 days. However once you are with them, the clinicians are good and the surgery itself is pleasant.

Response #3:

It's usually a 2 week wait for an appointment. GP's often pushing anti-depressants as a 'care for all' and not listening to symptoms. Relying on blood tests results and dismissing actual symptoms. Little continuity of care as it's hard to get an appointment when you need it with one Dr.

Response #4:

Hard to get an appointment.

Response #5:

Excellent access for mobility (e.g. stroller). Excellent availability for GP's and Nurses, very helpful team on phones and at the surgery. Superb medical care.

Response #6:

The 2 week wait for an appointment is excruciating, not to be missed.

Response #7:

I find the care and understanding varies from doctor to doctor, some doctors at the surgery are really caring and understanding and others make it clear that it is just their job.

Very friendly and helpful Doctors and Nurses, especially the District Nurses - always feel as though they are almost looking forward to seeing me! I'm very impressed with the care.

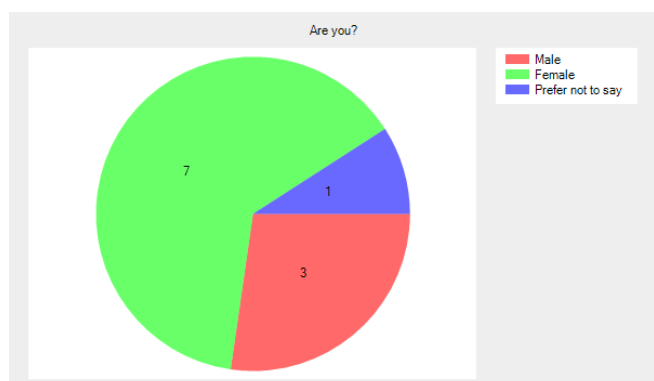
Response #11:

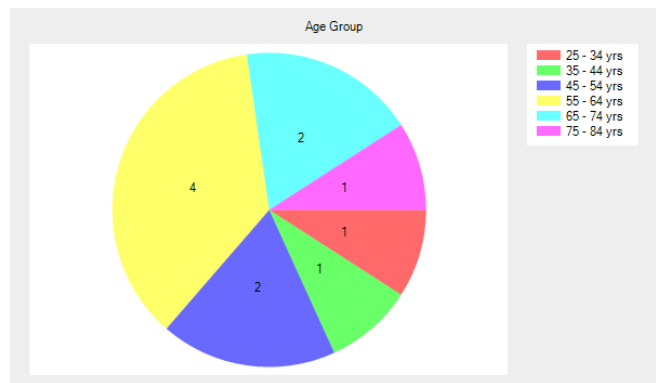
**Are you?**

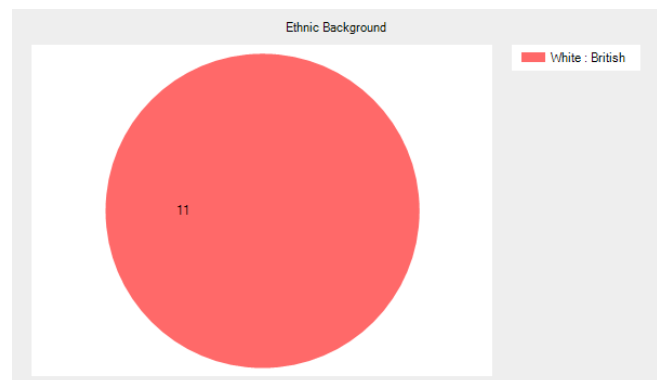

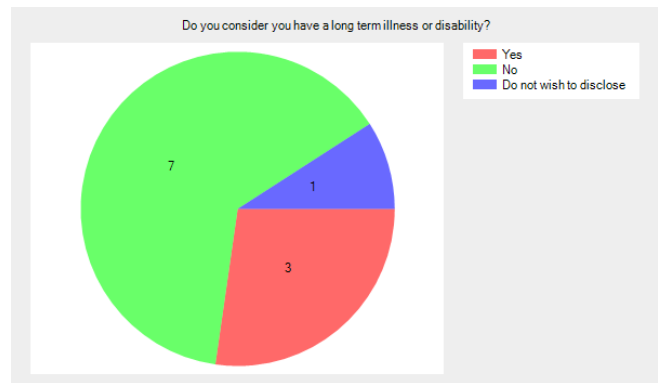
